Artist's dialogue:

In this context, I have participated in a Fellowship Program focusing on Climate Change to create a dialogue across borders through the arts.
- During the lockdowns in the Covid-19 pandemic, we observed humans across the globe connected via virtual mediums. This helped us tap into

our sub-conscious communication skills. While this unexpected situation made us realize the value of life itself, I found my spiritual and meditative practices guiding me at a deeper level. It was this purpose which led me to launch a coffee table book talking about my artistic journey.






